Valid From: 5/3/2015 Valid Until: 31/3/2015

Dredging operations on Tamar River will commence on Thursday, 05 March 2015 and conclude on Tuesday, 31 March 20015 at Kings

Wharf Launceston.

Dredging operations will take place on the eastern side of the Tamar River adjacent to Kings Wharf. Dredge *MILIMILI* and associated pipework will be anchored on the eastern edge of the channel.

Pipe position will be marked with yellow flotation buoys and red navigation lights.

Mariners should navigate with caution.

Working With Children Registration Card.

Under the Working with Vulnerable People Act, ALL volunteers who come into contact with children within a sporting organisation must apply for a <u>Working With</u> Children Registration Card.

This registration must be done before the first of April 2015 and it must be done by each individual volunteer. The Tamar Yacht Club cannot apply on your behalf.

The cost for volunteers is \$17.76 and the club will refund this to you if required. The link to start your application online is as follows.


If you are unable to complete the application online you will need to attend a Service Tasmania office and pick up an application form.
