



2017 State Trophy

In previous years the State Trophy has been awarded to the top performing State/Territory based on their results over the Australian Youth Sailing Grand Prix (AYSGP). With the AYSGP being discontinued the State Trophy will be awarded based on the results at the 2017 Australian Youth Championships.

Results from the following classes (WS Youth Worlds categories) will count towards the trophy:

- Laser Radial Boys
- Laser Radial Girls
- 29er Boys
- 29er Girls
- 420 Boys
- 420 Girls
- Bic Techno Boys
- Bic Techno Girls

Scoring will be based on a low points system with the top two sailors from each State in each class counting towards the State Trophy:

- 1st – 1 point
- 2nd – 2 points
- 3rd – 3 points
- 4th – 4 points
- and so on till 10th = 10 points

The Score for a State which have an entrant in the class but they are not within the top 10 and for each state not having any entrant competing in a category = 11 points, i.e. a state with no entrants in a class would score 22 points for that class.

If the class has less than 10 entries, then the maximum points for any sailor/pair will be based on number of entrants + 1

Where a double-handed pair comprises sailors from two states, both sailors will contribute their overall position/points to their respective States total points.

International entrants will be disregarded when calculating results.
