Springsail Regatta & Coaching Clinic 23rd-26th September 2017 Q & A

Q. Can I purchase lunch during the coaching program and regatta?

A. RGYC will have available a pre ordering lunch facility for every day of the regatta and coaching clinic. Please order lunches through the online entry process. Breakfast will be available every day from the café and Soos' BBQ. Snacks and drinks will be available throughout the day, both at the OTB canteen, and the Marina View Café.

Q. Will the Club be open during the coaching program and regatta?

A. The café will be open from 7:30 am Saturday-Tuesday, and open for dinner on Friday and Saturday evening. There will be a sausage sizzle on Sunday following racing, and the coaching clinic BBQ on Monday night (bookings essential). The bar will be open from 11am Saturday & Sunday, and from 3pm on Monday and Tuesday.

Q. Can I purchase extra tickets for the Monday night coaching clinic BBQ?

A. Yes, Tickets are available at registration.

Q. When can I drop my boat off at RGYC?

A. All boats can be dropped off at RGYC all day Friday 22nd September until 19:00 hrs, and from 07:30 on Saturday 23rd Sept, or by arrangement with the regatta office on 0437 689 928.

Q. When can I register for the regatta?

A. If you have enrolled in the coaching program you can register at the registration desk at the same time for the Springsail Regatta. Otherwise registration desk will be opened on Monday 25th Sept. from 08:15 for the coaching clinic. Please refer to the NOR.

Q. How does the registration process work at the regatta?

A. Once you have arrived at the regatta make your way to the registration office located in the main clubhouse. You will be required to look over your information and ensure your details are correct and have not changed. A parent/guardian (competitors 17 and under) must sign the declaration form. Any changes to competitor details can be made at that time. Once the racing is underway competitors will be required to fill in a change of competitor details form, available at registration desk.

Q. Coach/Support/Spectator Boats.

A. All coach / support / spectator visiting RHIBS / boats must register on arrival. Registration is through the regatta online entry portal [HERE](#). . Support vessel personnel must hold a working with Children Check Card.

Q. Is there storage for my boat trailer?

A. Trailer storage is available at the Highlight Park area adjacent to the car park. Although this area will be fenced off, it is strongly recommended that a suitable locking device or chain is used to secure your trailer. The RGYC grounds will only be available for race management support boat trailers.

Q. Where is the nearest boat ramp?

A. You can launch and retrieve off the public ramp located at Limeburners point, a short drive from the Club (See Appendix A) It is asked that you do not use the RGYC grounds for launching and retrieval due to the congested nature of the hardstand area.

Q. Can my boat stay in the water during the regatta?

A. Yes RIB's can stay in the water, overnight. Please ensure you have registered your boat [online](#), refer to the YV website and confirmed your registration at the regatta desk before berthing your vessel.

Q. Where do I park my car?

A. Parking is available along Ritchie Boulevard. This area is free on Weekends, but time restrictions may apply. There are a number of parking options available a short walk from the Club (see attachment B)

Q. Where can I purchase spares for my boat.

A. Powerdrive Marine will be onsite at the regatta stocking general hardware and Zhik sailing apparel. Their onsite shop will be located in the OTB building, at the junction of the boat yard and the walkway to the male change rooms. Powerdrive Marine is located at [11 Yarra St, Geelong 3220](#)

Q. Will there be a sailmaker available over the regatta and coaching clinic?

A. Bull Sails, operated by Tony Bull has a sail loft onsite at RGYC. He is contactable on 0438 212 930.

Q. Will there be a spectator boat on the water?

A. There are no spectator boats allocated on the water, but if you are interested in volunteering for either the regatta or coaching clinic, we will do our best to get you on the right course area. Contact Mike Williams on 0437 689 928 for further information.

Q. Where are the toilets and change rooms at RGYC?

A. There is male and female change rooms located downstairs in the OTB building. The female rooms are located on the Eastern side near the sail loft, and the male rooms are located along the locker area on the Western side. There are also toilet and change room facilities located in the main clubhouse. (Please see Appendix C for a map of the RGYC grounds).
