

2017 Trinity Point NSW Youth Championships FAQs

Q. Can I purchase food and drink during the regatta?

A. Full catering will be available from the Club during the regatta.

Breakfast will be available Saturday, Sunday and Monday.

Competitor lunch packs can be pre-ordered with your entry. Options available from the Club include; fresh sandwiches, hot food (chips, nuggets, pies, sausage rolls), steak and sausage sandwiches

After racing a free competitor sausage in bread will be available

Club Café and licensed bar will be open across the regatta.

A coffee van will be onsite on both Saturday, Sunday and Monday morning.

Q. When can I drop my boat off at SMLASC?

A. On Friday 29 September from 12 noon.

Q. When is the Regatta Office open.

A. The regatta office is open from the 10 December from 4pm – 6pm at Woollahra Sailing Club. All competitors who have registered via the online registration are required to check all competitor details before the first race. Please refer to the competitor schedule for the opening hours of the regatta office.

Q. When can I register for the regatta?

A. Registration will be located inside the Club house. Early registration will be held on Friday after from 4pm – 6pm and starting from 8.30am on Saturday morning.

Q. When is the Regatta Office open.

A. The regatta office is open from the 29 September from 4pm – 6pm at SLMAS. All competitors who have registered via the online registration are required to check all competitor details before the first race. Please refer to the competitor schedule for the opening hours of the regatta office.

Q. How does the registration process work at the regatta?

A. Once you have arrived at the regatta make your way to the registration office. You will be required to check your information to ensure your details are correct. A parent/guardian (competitors 17 and under) must sign the declaration form. Any changes to competitor details can be made at this time. Once racing is underway, competitors will be required to fill in a change of competitor details form, available at registration desk.

Q. Where do I place my boat for rigging?

A. A map shall be posted on the website outlining the rigging areas for all competitors. Junior Classes shall be placed in and around the club house. Please refer to map.

Q. Coach/Support/Spectator Boats

A. All coach / support / spectator visiting RHIBS / boats must register prior to arrival via www.youthchamps.org.au

Q. Is their storage for my boat trailer?

A. Yes, there is plenty of storage onsite.

Q. Where is the nearest boat ramp?

A. The boat ramp is located within walking distance to the club with easy launching. Please bring a VHF radio for your coach boat. There will be a secure trot line to tie to overnight in front of the Club.

Q. Can my boat stay in the water during the regatta?

A. Yes RIB's can stay in the water, overnight. Please ensure you have registered your boat online via www.youthchamps.org.au – **2017 NSW Youth Champs Coach and Support Boat Registration** and confirm your registration at the regatta desk before berthing your vessel on the trotline. Terms and Conditions apply which can be found when registering your vessel.

Q. Where do I park my car?

A. Off-street car and trailer parking has been arranged in conjunction with Council.

Please assist the smooth arrival of all competitors by following the direction of Club volunteers (in fluro vests) upon arrival and departure. Please consider local residents by driving slowly when entering and leaving via Sunshine Parade and do not block private driveways in nearby streets.

Q. Where can I purchase fuel?

A. If you are bringing your own coach boat we recommend filling your gas tanks and possibly a jerry can prior to arrival as the closest gas station is a five minute drive by road.

Q. Where can I purchase Apparel and spares for my boat?

A. Our partner Zhik, will be on site with a pop up shop. Other supplies for boat parts will be available onsite during the regatta including; NB Sail Sports, PSA, Bic Open and others TBC.

Q. What accommodation is available in and around South Lake Macquarie?

A. There is an array of accommodation in and around South Lake Macquarie. Our official partner for accommodation is **Bay Hotel Motel 330 Fishery Point Rd, Bonnells Bay, NSW 2264** Phone: (02) 4973 3177. All rooms have been placed on hold for competitors to book.
