

2018 Tamar Yacht Club Tas Youth Championships FAQs

Q. Can I purchase food and drink during the regatta?

A. Lunch and snacks will be available for both days of the regatta.

Competitor lunch packs can be pre-ordered with your entry. Options available from the Club include; ham and salad rolls, chicken wraps, pies, sausage rolls, and toasted sandwiches (2) (ham, cheese, tomato or any combination of the above). Lunch packs will be \$10 and include one of the above, a soft drink, piece of fruit and cake or chocolate bar.

After racing a free competitor sausage in bread will be available.

Coffees will be available from the canteen.

Q. When can I drop my boat off at TYC Beauty Point?

A. On Friday 2nd March from 12 noon. Please contact the Marina caretaker on 0418321339.

Q. When can I register for the regatta?

A. Registration will be located inside the Club house. Registration will be starting from 8.30am on Saturday morning.

Q. When is the Regatta Office open.

A. The regatta desk is open on Sat the 3rd March from 0830 at TYC Beauty Point. All competitors who have registered via the online registration are required to check all competitor details before the first race.

Q. How does the registration process work at the regatta?

A. Once you have arrived at the regatta make your way to the registration desk. You will be required to check your information to ensure your details are correct. A parent/guardian (competitors 17 and under) must sign the declaration form. Any changes to competitor details can be made at this time. Once racing is underway, competitors will be required to fill in a change of competitor details form, available at registration desk.

Q. Where do I place my boat for rigging?

A. The grass areas in front and to the north of the Green shed, and in front of the clubhouse are available for rigging.

Q. Coach/Support/Spectator Boats

A. All coach / support / spectator visiting RHIBS / boats must register prior to arrival via www.youthchamps.org.au

Q. Is there storage for my boat trailer?

A. Yes, there is plenty of storage onsite.

Q. Where is the nearest boat ramp?

A. The boat ramp is located within walking distance to the club with easy launching at Inspection Head. Please bring a VHF radio for your coach boat. There will be pens allocated within the marina for overnight mooring of coach boats.

Q. Can my boat stay in the water during the regatta?

A. Yes RIB's can stay in the water, overnight. Please ensure you have registered your boat online via www.youthchamps.org.au – **Youth Champs Support Boat Registration** and confirm your registration at the regatta desk before berthing your vessel on the trotline. Terms and Conditions apply which can be found when registering your vessel.

Q. Where do I park my car?

A. Off-street car and trailer parking is in the Marina carpark adjacent to the TYC club house.

Please assist the smooth arrival of all competitors by removing your boat from the trailer in the carpark and wheeling it through to the rigging area.

Q. Where can I purchase fuel?

A. If you are bringing your own coach boat we recommend filling your gas tanks and possibly a jerry can prior to arrival as the closest gas station is a five minute drive by road.

Q. Where can I purchase Apparel and spares for my boat?

A. We recommend being self sufficient as the closest chandler is 45 mins drive away and is only open Saturday until 1600 hrs, closed Sunday.

Q. What accommodation is available in and around Beauty Point?

A. There is an array of accommodation in and around Beauty Point, the Tamar Valley and nearby Launceston
