NOR 11 - Jury is deleted

NOR 12 and SI 17 Scoring is deleted and replaced with:

17 Scoring

- 17.1 Three races are required to be completed to constitute a series.
- 17.2 When fewer than 2 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores. This changes RRS A2.1.
- 17.3 When 3 to 5 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score. This changes RRS A2.1.
- 17.4 When 6 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her two worst scores. This changes RRS A2.1.
- 17.5 To request correction of an alleged error in posted race or series results a boat shall complete a scoring enquire form available at and to be submitted to the regatta office.

Information about the weather

There is a Gale Warning for Port Philip on Saturday and the forecasts indicate that those predicted gale force winds will occur across the entire bay. The forecast and actual conditions will be monitored by the Organising Committee which includes Australian Sailing and the SSCBC. Safety policies and best practice will be followed.







Based on the forecast, the ability to race in suitable conditions on Saturday is quite at risk and the Organising Committee will meet on Friday 13 April, 2018 at 1830 hrs to review the forecasts, models and actual conditions. Information will be posted on Youth Champs Website, social media and email sent to all competitors after this time.

The forecasts and models for Sunday suggest that racing is quite possible; however the models can evolve as we get closer to the start time.
