CASUAL DAILY HIRE OF TYC CLUB DINGHIES

Policy

Purpose

To ensure club dinghies are allocated to hirers of appropriate skill, utilized for appropriate purposes and returned in an acceptable condition after use.

General

To undertake a casual hire of a club dinghy the hirer must be a member of TYC.

Only Club boats not already chartered for the season and not required for training or other purposes will be available for casual hire.

To undertake a casual hire the hire must be approved by the Chairman of Small Boats, the RO or one of the small boats training instructors to ensure that boats are allocated to sailors of appropriate skill levels.

Any club boat taken out which is not part of an organized training session is subject to a casual hire arrangement.

Casual hire fees must be paid on the day of hire.

No boat may be taken out on casual hire without a rescue boat being on the water to accompany the hirer.

The hirer must abide by all instructions of the race committee/rescue boat crews and the rules of sailing.

Rescue boat crews are to be notified of casual hire participants and the RO is to be advised if casual hire sailors are not participating in racing on the day.

Casual hire fees do not cover race entry fees.

If a sailor undertaking a casual hire wishes to enter the day's racing they are required to complete an entry form and pay the entry fee.
