

Frequently Asked Questions for Motor Boat Licence Courses

1. What time does the course start and finish?

The course runs from 9am in the morning with the theory component being taught in the Park St club house. The afternoon is reserved for the practical component of the course and finish time will depend on the number of people in the course. We can make allowances for people that have other commitments, please advise Instructor on the day if you need to leave earlier than the finish time of approximately 3pm.

2. How much does the course cost?

The course cost is \$170, and covers the cost of your licence.

3. When do I receive my licence?

A temporary licence will be issued on the day of your course, once all components of the course have been successfully completed. A card licence is no longer issued from MAST, however your licence information is stored on their data system for queries.

4. How do I book for the course?

The forms and dates that the courses are being run, are on the TYC website. To ensure a booking in a particular course, the completed enrolment form needs to be returned to the TYC office in Park St and course fee paid. Office hours are Tues to Friday 9 am until 3pm. Phone payments are available.

5. What can I study prior to the course?

MAST (Marine and Safety Tasmania) produce the "Tasmanian Safe Boating Handbook". This booklet is available from Service Tasmania, Tamar Marine and the Tamar Yacht Club. It can also be downloaded from the following link:
